Engineer:

- Mark Bahnick, Borough Engineer and Darren Thomas met to discuss the Mill Street paving project. Darren had concerns regarding the (2) 6” water lines going down Mill Street. Craig will be asked to determine if these water lines are abandoned prior to the project.

Other Business:

- Line stop pricing for Green Street valve is tabled until July’s meeting.

Property/Water Operations:

- Tara will notify Lang’s Landscaping to price quote us on the following (clear easement behind Craig & Manor Drive residents). A. stump grind all big tree stumps after clearing area B. advise contractor that a notice will be sent to all homeowners adjacent to the water easement that they have 60 days to remove all their personal belongings off our property, if left there and contractor accidentally damages, while clearing the lot, it will not fall back on the contractor or Authority for the damaged occurred. C. Contractor will provide price quote to clear entire easement from Towhee Drive down to Fireline Road.
- On May 23, the stand pipe was overflowing. Craig was unable to connect remotely and discovered the modem was bad. Craig had to run the system manually for several days until new modem was installed.
- **A motion was made by Darren Thomas, 2nd Chad Everett to install a new wire to Well #1, Motion carried.** Joe Liberti will be notified to do such when he schedules a day to investigate the issues to Well #1.
- Craig LaBarre will schedule with DEP a date to inspect the water system.
